Lessons consist of the placement of the chock blocks and trailer tires, the arrangement of pallets to spread out the load right, and checks needed before driving into a trailer at a dock location. Courses also consist of Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) training. Though not related directly to the operation of a lift truck, MSDS training is important if an operator notices a leaking container or damages a container containing toxic materials. MSDS sheets list the correct ways of dealing with spills, the products and their effects on people.
