Aerial Lift Training Kitchener - An aerial work platform is a mechanized access platform. This machinery provides access to otherwise inaccessible areas for equipment or people. Likewise referred to as an elevating work platform or aerial device, the device is often utilized to access high areas. Maintenance and construction staff often have to make use of aerial work platforms on the job. They are utilized by firefighters for emergency access.

Designed for temporary application, aerial work platforms are different from elevators, which provide permanent access to high areas. An aerial work platform is intended to be operated by a single person, and is capable of lifting weights of less than one ton. Some kinds have higher load limits. There are various kinds of aerial work platforms; for instance, there is a "cherry picker" and a "scissor lift".

A lot of the aerial work platforms are equipped together with compressed air connectors for power tools and electrical outlets. For specialist jobs, like lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform could come with special equipment.

Those who want to operate an aerial lift machine must undergo training. Normally, the members of a Health & Safety Committee and their representatives are responsible for the inspection of each equipment and work places and are also needed to undergo training. Those training would become familiar with aerial lifting device operation. They would likewise know the rules which apply to safely using these machinery. Rules vary from province to province, and within worksites that are federally regulated.

Any worker who is required to work near or lifted by an aerial lifting machine has to be informed regarding potential hazards. An Aerial Lift Training Video can be shown in a general safety session to educate all of the employees who work near them or are lifted by them.

The majority of Aerial Lift Training Program will include modules which are focused on the following areas: hazard Identification; Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices; and Platform Positioning & Park Positioning. The particular program is meant to train staff on the safe operation of self-propelled, boom supported elevated work platform and self-propelled, elevated work platform. Employees who finish the program would receive a certificate, signed by a qualified person to be able to verify the successful completion of a hands-on practical exam.
